A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

Since 1989, the Oratory has offered a summer school for lay people. There are two week-long sessions, with three classes each day, taught by one of the Fathers or Brothers of the Oratory. A special Mass is celebrated. And lunch is served. The day begins at 8:30 a.m. and ends at 3:00 p.m. The Oratory can accommodate a limited number of people in the seminary residence. The fee for the course is \$175 per session, which includes lunch. The surcharge for rooms in the seminary residence is \$75 per week. Dates for Session 2: July 9-13, 2018 – The topic for the Second Session will be: **The Church in the Apostolic Age**:

Many non-Catholics reject most of the distinctly Catholic practices as human traditions, not founded on Scripture. The Church's understanding of the sacraments and the nature of the Church itself are often seen as mere imports from pagan culture. They present the reformation as a return to a truly Bible-based Christianity.

But even an introductory study of the time of the Apostles and their immediate successors (the Apostolic Fathers) shows that this view does not stand the test of history. What the Church believed then, at the time of the apostles themselves, was decidedly Catholic, recognizably what we still believe and always believed.

Studying these first generations of Catholics is both a great blessing and provides answers to many questions about our faith.
