## **MARRIAGES:**

Couples planning to be married must contact a priest well in advance of the wedding date. They must also receive personal preparation for entering marriage.

If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

#### The Oratory Summer School

Since 1989, the Oratory has offered a summer school for lay people. There are two week-long sessions, with three classes each day, taught by one of the Fathers or Brothers of the Oratory. A special Mass is celebrated. And lunch is served. The day begins at 8:30 a.m. and ends at 3:00 p.m. The Oratory can accommodate a limited number of people in the seminary residence. **The fee for the course is \$175 per session, which includes lunch. The surcharge for rooms in the seminary residence is \$75 per week.** Please note that the courses are aimed at adults and older teens.

**Dates for Session 2: July 9-13, 2018** – The topic for the Second Session will be: ***The Church in the Apostolic Age:***

*Many non-Catholics reject most of the distinctly Catholic practices as human traditions, not founded on Scripture. The Church's understanding of the sacraments and the nature of the Church itself are often seen as mere imports from pagan culture. They present the reformation as a return to a truly Bible-based Christianity.*

*But even an introductory study of the time of the Apostles and their immediate successors (the Apostolic Fathers) shows that this view does not stand the test of history. What the Church believed then, at the time of the apostles themselves, was decidedly Catholic, recognizably what we still believe and always believed.*

*Studying these first generations of Catholics is both a great blessing and provides answers to many questions about our faith.*

## Mission Preacher -- July 7 / 8

Fr Moses Iyogwoya is a priest of the Missionary Society of  
 St Paul of Nigeria, for missions in Africa and beyond. They  
 run rural schools, but also provide medical and other material  
 assistance when needed. Some of the mission priests work in  
 countries where many children are victims of war, for  
 instance, country like Sudan, Chad, Liberia and in the  
 northern part of Nigeria face with the Islamic sect (Boko  
 haram), etc. They come across children whose parents died  
 during the war or as a result of diseases, and it is their  
 responsibility to give life to these children. They do not just  
 go and give help but they live with the people they serve.

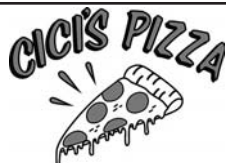
