MARRIAGES:

Couples planning to be married must contact a priest well in advance of the wedding date. They must also receive personal preparation for entering marriage.

If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

Thank God Grant Pitre proposed to the daughter of a Protestant minister, or this book would not have been written. The scathing arguments the pastor produced forced Grant to explore his Catholic Faith, and was able to discover how biblical, and how fulfilling of the Old Testament, the Eucharist is.
