MARRIAGES:

Couples planning to be married must contact a priest well in advance of the wedding date. They must also receive personal preparation for entering marriage.

If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

Special Maintenance Collection Today

At the end of the heating season, the boiler in the church sprang a leak. To fix the broken part in the boiler would cost \$20K and we would be left with a boiler for which parts would be impossible to obtain in the future. So we decided to do things properly. The church needs 1.2 MegaBtu to heat. One such heater now costs about \$50K. And the parish cannot just run with one functioning heater because if it breaks in the winter, the building would freeze. So we have decided to go with three 400 KiloBtu heaters instead. These are much less expensive at \$9K each. If one breaks, the remaining two can easily keep the building at a serviceable temperature while it is being replaced. But there is a one time cost in reconfiguring the plumbing and the exhaust. So the cost of the project, which is well under way, is \$54K plus HST rather than just 3 x \$9K = \$27K. There will be close to \$20K of Family of Faith money to help pay for this. But we need to find the extra \$34K somewhere. That is why we are having a special collection today. We thank you in advance for your generosity.
