MARRIAGES:

Couples planning to be married must contact a priest well in advance of the wedding date. They must also receive personal preparation for entering marriage.

If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

The Catholic Church faces a major crisis and the turmoil in priestly ministry is at the heart of it. Drawing on Vatican II, they present priestly celibacy as more than "a mere precept of ecclesiastical law." They insist that renewal of the Church is bound to a renewed understanding of priestly vocation as sharing in Jesus' priestly identity as Bridegroom of the Church.

The language of the consultation questionnaire is not great; nonetheless, the questionnaire does allow you to leave further comments.

Before responding to the questionnaire, it is important to keep in mind these important points to help you respond:

- Historical: Canadian Senate passed euthanasia law in time for summer break.
- Canada's euthanasia deaths increased by 50% in 2018
- Ontario euthanasia deaths are rising quickly.
- UN Disability rights envoy urges changes to Canada's euthanasia law.
- Québec court expands euthanasia law by striking down the terminal illness requirement.
- Physically healthy depressed man died by euthanasia in BC.
- Québec Fourth Interim Euthanasia Report, 13 deaths did not comply with the law.
- BC Health Minister orders Delta Hospice to do euthanasia by February 3.
