If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

It was an important celebration of the spiritual fruitfulness of the Catholic Counter-Reformation. The anniversary gives us the opportunity to reflect on the idea of sanctity and the powerful example that the saints give us, the Church's beginning to recognize various Christians as saints in the liturgy, and the canonical process of canonization the Church developed. Saint Philip was convinced that Catholics should give more attention to lives of the saints—reading books that begin with the letter "S", like Saint Augustine, Saint Benedict, etc.
