## **MARRIAGES:**

Couples planning to be married must contact a priest well in advance of the wedding date. They must also receive personal preparation for entering marriage.

If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

 The Church has proclaimed 2026 as a Jubilee Year in honour of the 800<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the death of St. Francis of Assisi. St. Francis's personal conversion did more than turn a wealthy young nobleman into *il poverello*, a simple and devout saint who renounced his earthly possessions. He was God's instrument to refocus the Church upon the simplicity of the Gospel message. The drama of his life and message has inspired the imagination of artists, poets, and filmmakers, and the admiration of innumerable people, both inside and outside the Church. He lives on most especially in those men and women who have chosen to follow his way of poverty and service. The Church has been enriched by his poverty.

**The cost for each session, which includes lunch each day for those attending in person, is \$200 per person. For those attending online, the cost is \$175 per person.
