MARRIAGES:

Couples planning to be married must contact a priest well in advance of the wedding date. They must also receive personal preparation for entering marriage.

If either party has previously gone through any form of civil or religious marriage with another person, the priest is not permitted to set a date for the wedding until the Bishop's office has been consulted.

It should be noted that Catholics, in order to marry validly, must marry before the parish priest or his delegate and two witnesses. A civil marriage or a marriage before a non-Catholic minister is not a valid marriage. Couples in such "marriages" should contact a priest to have the situation rectified.

PASTOR'S CORNER

Over the past few weeks, in the missal of St Paul VI, the Gospels were taken from chapter 13 of St Matthew. In that chapter, Our Lord goes by the sea of Galilee, gets into a boat, and teaches. On that day, he gave his followers seven parables.

Where else does the number seven appear in the Scriptures? At the beginning and at the end. There are seven days of creation (Gen 1). Seven appears repeatedly in the final book of Scripture, most notably in the seven headed dragon (Revelation 13). But throughout the Scriptures, the number seven also features in key places. How many years of plenty and famine does Joseph the patriarch predict? Seven. How many times does Joshua march around Jericho before its walls fall down? Seven. How many gifts of the Holy Spirit does Isaiah say will rest on the Messiah? Seven (Isaiah 11:1-2). How many petitions, requests, are contained in the Our Father? Seven (Matthew 5).

Seven is the number of completion, perfection, totality. Seven is the number of newness and victory. Seven is the number of cleansing and transformation. How many times did Elijah tell Naaman to wash in the river Jordan so as to be cleansed of leprosy? Seven.

Why then does Our Lord tell seven parables? He says that those who understand these, will be like a wise man who can bring from his storehouse what is new and what is old.

According to one saint, "the sacraments are meant especially as a remedy for the guilt and the effects of past sins" (Summa theologiae, IIIa, q. 62, a. 2. Ad 1). We can apply this passage from St Thomas to Our Lord's words. The past = what is old. The seven parables show us how to enter the kingdom of heaven by overcoming the effects of past sins. The seven sacraments correspond to the seven parables.

As we get ready for our 125th anniversary as a parish, let us remember that the parish exists as a place for the sacraments. Christ's Church grows and is healed by these seven great gifts. In this church, people can be baptized (have original sin removed), confirmed (strength against fear of rejection), receive the Eucharist (healed of concupiscence), go to confession (forgiven of actual sins), anointed (strengthened against trials of death, caused by original sin), married (remedy against loneliness), and ordained (remedy against losing spiritual leaders).
